Himachal Pradesh, Uttarakhand reported significant jump in forest fires between 2022-23 and 2023-24

124 Human-animal conflicts

Human deaths due to elephant attacks rose by 11% in 2022-23, compared to 2021-22

127 Leopard population

Over half of the leopard population in 2022 was outside tiger reserves

129 Environmental crimes

At its current rate, Indian courts will need 14 years and 6 months to clear all the cases registered under the Wildlife Protection Act

133 STATE OF AGRICULTURE

134 Organic cultivation

Despite doubling the certified area in the past three years, India's organic agricultural production dropped by 14.88%

137 Farmer suicides

In 2022, an average of over 30 farmers and farm labourers committed suicide every day

139 Farmers' unrest

India recorded 195 major farmer protests across 22 states since 2023

144 Groundwater availability

17 states/UTs have locations where groundwater is being extracted at a rate faster than recharge

146 Micro irrigation schemes

India saw a 6.5% rise in micro irrigation schemes from 2013-14 to 2017-18, but their total irrigation potential declined by nearly 1%

164 Quality of jobs

While there has been employment generation in India, serious concerns remain over the lack of quality and productive jobs
