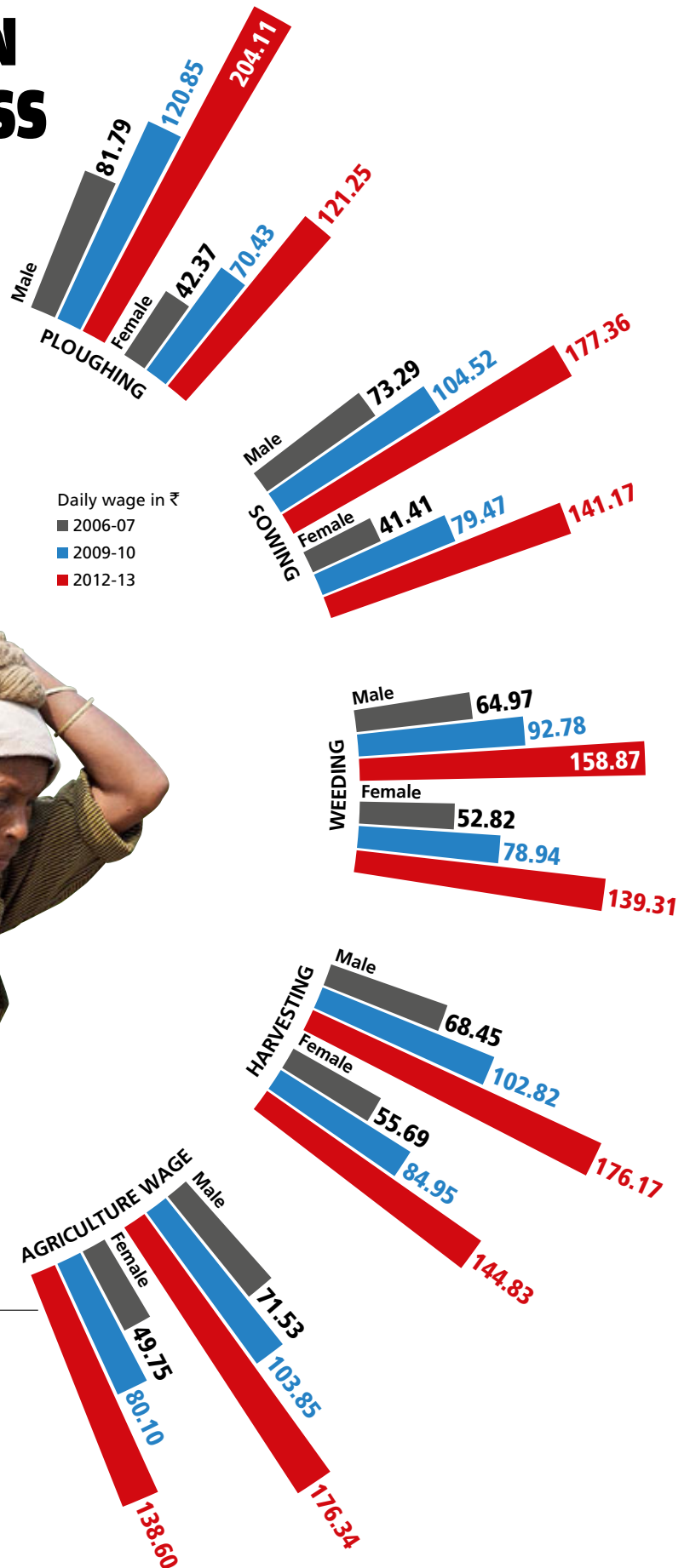


HOW WOMEN ARE PAID LESS IN FARMING

Since women often do a lot of agricultural tasks as part of their household chores, their roles remain largely unrecognised and they are paid almost nothing, suggest government data.

Indian women, on an average spend 30 hours a week on unpaid labour. This is over and above the 25 hours a week they spend on household chores
